OUR IMPACT

Live Your Dream supports women and children in Utah. Since



our inception in 2010, we have awarded 212 scholarships, totaling \$357,634.89, to single mothers who desire to attend college, university, technical school, Bootcamp, or any education that will increase their earning potential to help them better provide for their family. We award scholarships in the fall and winter/ spring. All recipients go through an application process and can apply for a scholarship multiple times.



Because of the number of scholarships awarded to single mothers since our inception, over **490** children have a greater probability of gaining a higher education.

Gaining a college education impacts families, friends, and communities for generations to come. Children with mothers who have a higher education are more likely to attend college, participate in civic activities, and be more involved with their future children.* We are helping to break the poverty cycle in our community. According to the US Census Bureau reports, 40% of all single mothers live below the federal poverty level. In Utah, one in four households with a single mother (25.3%) are living below the poverty level. This percentage increases with the number of children in the household: 48.8% of single-mother households with five or more children live below the poverty level.** The DWS reports, "Obtaining a quality education increases employment opportunities, increases lifetime earnings, and supports economic stability for parents and their children."





SCHOOL ATTENDANCE OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS


